What is Inclusion Works® ?

Inclusion Works® is an evidence-based inclusion program developed by L4Life for schools, kindergartens and childcare centres. It works alongside educators in real classrooms to support inclusive teaching practices that help all children participate and learn.

The focus is on practical, everyday strategies that educators can use with confidence, rather than theory or one-off training.

Why schools and early years services use Inclusion Works®

Schools and early years settings are supporting increasingly diverse learning and behaviour needs. Many educators are looking for practical, in-class support to strengthen inclusive practice across the whole classroom. Inclusion Works® supports leaders, educators and support staff to:

- Build consistent, inclusive classroom practices
- Increase teacher confidence and capability
- Strengthen learning environments for all children
- Address inclusion early, before challenges escalate

What Inclusion Works® focuses on

- Whole-class inclusive teaching practices
- Supporting educators to work with diverse learners
- Practical strategies that can be used every day

Inclusion Works® is not disability-specific and is not therapy-based. It focuses on strengthening inclusive practice for all learners.
